

## **2017-2018 Division 22 Compliance**

Annually, the District is required to report to the Board and community compliance with Oregon's Division 22 standards, the laws which govern education.

This year a change was made, and Districts now report on compliance for the complete, prior school year. Previously we gave a mid-year report on that year's ongoing status.

The full report was presented to the School Board, as in most years, at the January meeting. Triangle Lake Charter School is compliant with all but one requirement and is exempt from some.

Below is a brief overview of Division 22 process, and then we list the areas where we report ourselves as non-compliant, along with either the reason or the action plan.

The Blachly School District is a single-school, K-12 district. Annually, the Superintendent reviews the required standards and researches our compliance with Division 22. Because we are small, Dr. Brookins has direct contact on a daily basis with the Business Manager, the Facilities Manager, the Testing Coordinator, the Special Education Director, the Title Director, the Counselor, the District Security Administrator, and all others who would inform Division 22 reporting. The Superintendent is directly responsible for research and reporting concerning compliance. For the 2017-2018 report, Dr. Brookins reviewed the standards and consulted with staff to make his compliance decisions.
