Dear TLCS Community,

We want to provide you an update on how Blachly School District will respond to Governor Brown's Two-Week Freeze message from Friday, November 13, and subsequent Executive Order. We know these are difficult times and want to continue to provide excellent learning opportunities for our students.

The Two-Week Freeze measures will be in effect statewide from **November 18 through December 2**. These measures are critical in limiting the spread of COVID-19, reducing risk in communities more vulnerable to serious illness and death, and helping conserve hospital capacity so that all Oregonians can continue to have access to essential care.

**The Two-Week Freeze does not apply to K-12 schools, which follow *Ready Schools, Safe Learners* guidance issued by Oregon Department of Education.** Currently, the metrics for Lane County require us to remain in Comprehensive Distance Learning.

**What does this mean? Here is what we are currently doing:**

- TLCS will continue in Comprehensive Distance Learning.
- We are evaluating the ability to begin bringing very small, limited groups of students onto campus for short periods of time under Limited In-Person Instruction once the Freeze is lifted.
- Conditioning camp for high school football players will continue outdoors, with explicit safety guidelines and no contact.
- Indoor conditioning sessions are canceled. All conditioning opportunities must be held outdoors for these groups.

Blachly School District will continue to follow *Ready Schools, Safe Learners* from ODE, and all safety and health protocols set forth by the Oregon Health Authority. We will continue to closely monitor our COVID numbers in Lane County and respond accordingly.
