Winter is coming and so are Winter Sports!

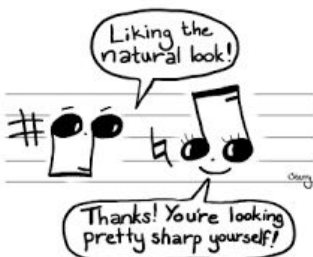
Middle school girls basketball practice starts Nov. 1st @ 3:15; first game Nov. 8th.

This, along with other changes, means that we need to increase the price of yearbooks for this year in order to meet the cost of creating, publishing, and printing them. Yearbooks for this year ordered prior to Thursday, November 25th will still cost the previous \$35. Any yearbooks ordered after November 25th, 2021 will cost \$40 to reflect the increase in production costs.

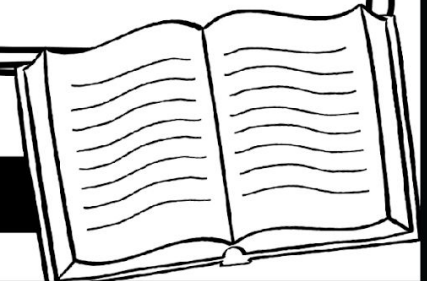
