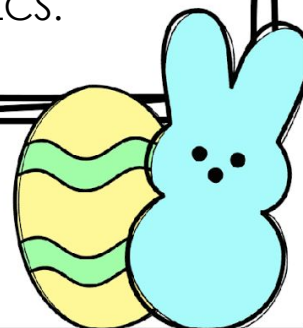

## **Easy No Butter Sugar Cookies**

2 3/4 Cups Whole Grain Flour or All Purpose

1 tsp. Baking Soda

1 tsp. Baking Powder

1/2 Cup Applesauce

1 1/2 Cups White Sugar

1 Egg

1 tsp. Vanilla Extract

Preheat oven to 375 degrees. In small bowl, mix flour, baking soda and baking powder. In large bowl, cream together applesauce and sugar until smooth, beat in egg and vanilla, then add your combined dry ingredients.

Roll dough into tablespoon size balls, place on cookie sheet and bake for 8 to 10 minutes.
