Hello TLCS Families -

We received guidance from the Governor, ODE, and OHA that they intended to allow schools to follow the newest recommendation from the CDC that students in school could be 3 feet apart (instead of 6 feet) while remaining masked during classroom instruction. On Monday 3/22, ODE released updated guidance reflecting these changes for schools to follow.

Our intention at TLCS is to return all students to in-person instruction every day if space allows. We will be reviewing our classroom sizes and spacing capacities the week we get back from Spring Break, in hopes to bring all of our students back to campus every day. There are some situations in which 6 feet of distancing is still required, so we need to assess all of our spaces and plan accordingly.

We hope to communicate to families that all students K-12 will be able to return to campus four days per week as early as April 5th, pending review of our building capacities with the revised guidance.

Families that choose to move to CDL or remain in CDL will continue to transition to our TLCS online program starting April 19th.

Thank you for your patience as we work through these constantly changing times, and our continued commitment to serve our students and families to the best of our ability. I hope you all have a restful and enjoyable Spring Break.
